1. Food Concession-Health Department requirements: All food concessions will require self-contained hot/cold running water, be three inches off the ground surface and be self-enclosed as per Riverside County California Health Department and Riverside Co. Dept. of Forestry.
2. Health Department Permit: As a food vendor, I have a current Riverside County Health Department permit for my booth and I am aware of the current Health Department regulations, if not you may request to be part of the District's Health Blanket coverage for an additional fee.
3. Water spigots: Due to limited available water spigots, vendors must supply their own hoses and hook-ups for water. Leaking systems will not be allowed.
4. Space Requirements/Costs: **All normal size space rentals are at the single space (12'x15') established rate of \$300.00 (Three hundred dollars).** If more space is required, there will be an additional fee. (Contact event coordinator).
5. Electrical Power Requirements/Costs. Please indicate your need:
110 Volts _____ Volts exceeding 20 amps will be assessed, and an additional \$50.00 fee for service will be applied.
6. Vendor Vehicles: Except for your booth or sales unit, vehicles belonging to vendors will not be allowed in the vendor area after the Biergarten opens each day. Parking will be in a designated area.
7. Unsigned or incomplete applications will not be honored and no space will be reserved. The Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District will review all applications, on a first come-first served basis, which have been properly endorsed and have rental payment enclosed. Be it known that after this agreement is made, goods for sale **CANNOT** be changed, without the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District's approval to the change in writing. All checks or money orders will be returned promptly if the application is rejected.

10. There will be a **\$25. fee applied to all returned checks** and you will need to come in and pay in cash to keep your space.
11. Oktoberfest **NEW** Hours: Friday 4:00 pm – 11:30 pm, Saturday 10:00am – 11:00 pm, Sunday 10:00am – 8:00 pm, **with the new hours food vendors may serve breakfast items.**
