BCVRPD Adult Softball Code of Conduct

All coaches, players, and spectators are responsible for knowing and adhering to the BCVRPD Adult Softball Code of Conduct. Beaumont-Cherry Valley Parks and Rec staff reserves the right to remove and/or prohibit a team, player, or manager from league play at any time due to inappropriate behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct.

NO PLAYER, COACH, OR SPECTATOR SHALL:

- 1. At any time, lay a hand upon, strike, shove, or verbally threaten an official, player, or spectator.
- 2. Refuse to abide by an officials decision.
- 3. Be guilty of obscene gestures, or objectionable demonstrations of dissent to officials decision.
- 4. Discuss with an official in any manner the decisions reached by such officials unless said player is the designated manager.
- 5. Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against the body and person of an opposing player.
- 6. Be guilty of abusive attacks or threatening statements upon any player, official or spectator.
- 7. Appear on the field to coach or play under the influence of drugs or alcohol in such a manner as to not have control of his facilities, nor shall he/she have possession of drugs or alcohol in the dugout or upon the playing field.
- 8. Demonstrate dissent by throwing bats, balls, gloves, or any other forceful action.
- 9. Bring illegal, altered or non-approved equipment onto the playing field.
- 10. Demonstrate unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 11. All users are recommended to wear masks for the entirety of their time on Noble Creek Regional Park premises.
- 12. Users are recommended not to share equipment when possible.
- 13. Users shall maintain a healthy distance of 6 feet apart from other plays when possible

Minimum Penalty: Ejection from game.

Maximum Penalty: Suspension from BCVRPD Softball league.
