Adult Softball Code of Conduct

All coaches, players and spectators are responsible for knowing and adhering to the Adult Softball Code of Conduct. Beaumont-Cherry Valley Parks and Recreation staff reserves the right to remove and/or prohibit a team, player, or manager from league play at anytime due to inappropriate behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct.

NO PLAYER, COACH OR SPECTATOR SHALL:

1. At any time, lay a hand upon, strike, shove, or verbally threaten an official, player or spectator.
2. Refuse to abide by an officials decision.
3. Be guilty of obscene gestures, or objectionable demonstrations of dissent to officials decision.
4. Discuss with an official in any manner the decisions reached by such officials unless said player is the designated manager.
5. Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against the body and person of an opposing player.
6. Be guilty of abusive attacks or threatening statements upon any player, official or spectator.
7. Appear on the field to coach or play under the influence of drugs or alcohol in such a manner as to not have control of his facilities, nor shall he/she have possession of drugs or alcohol in the dugout or upon the playing field.
8. Demonstrate dissent by throwing bats, balls, gloves, or any other forceful action
9. Bring illegal, altered or non-approved equipment onto the playing field.
10. Demonstrate unsportsmanlike conduct.

Minimum Penalty: Ejection from game

Maximum Penalty: Suspension from BCVRPD Softball leagues
