


# Pass Area Youth Baseball & Softball League FAQ's



## Can I still sign my child up for Spring 2026?

Yes, signups will continue through January 31st, at any PAYBS events or in the Noble Creek Community Center, located at 390 W. Oak Valley Parkway, Beaumont, CA 92223 during normal operating hours. Forms are available online if you would like to print them at home and bring them into the office.

## What will it cost to register my child?

The cost for Foal/Shetland/6U is **\$150**, all older divisions are **\$175**. For families that register more than one player, costs will be reduced by **\$25** per child after the first.

## If I signed up for BYBSB and paid more than the new prices, will I be refunded the difference?

Yes, the District will refund the difference to all parents who have already paid the full amount to BYBSB, please be prepared to provide proof of payment when completing the Refund Request Form.

## When will the Spring 2026 season start?

Practice games are scheduled to begin on **February 23<sup>rd</sup>**, and Opening Day/Picture Day has been moved to **Saturday, February 28<sup>th</sup>** due to Presidents' Week.

## What are the other critical dates I need to know?

Pancake Breakfast will be held Saturday, January 31<sup>st</sup> and Closing Day will be May 16<sup>th</sup>.

## Can I sign up to volunteer?

Yes, we absolutely need your help! Volunteers will be required to complete a background check. PAYBS will be using JDP for screening services and a Volunteer Form will be available this week.

## What will be different about the new league?

The goal of the District is to provide a more affordable league that is fun for the kids, focusing on fairness, equity, and development.

## How many games will my son or daughter have?

The goal is for your child to have 20 games for the Spring 2026 season.

## What happens if I already signed my child up for BYBSB Spring 2026 season?

Your child's name will automatically roll over to the Pass Area Youth Baseball & Softball Spring 2026 league, but PAYBS still needs to collect a Registration Form along with a Birth Certificate, Waiver of Release, and Code of Conduct signatures.

## Can I request a refund?

Yes, if you choose to remove your child from the league you can request a full refund by completing a Refund Request form and providing proof of payment, although we hope you will give the new league a chance.

## Can I request for my child to play on a specific team?

For the youngest divisions (Foal/Shetland/6U), PAYBS will attempt to accommodate player requests. All older divisions will allow one Coach to choose **ONE** Assistant Coach, Volunteer, OR Team Parent to prevent "stacking" of teams. Remember, we want to keep it fair.

## How will the teams be assigned?

District Staff will assign teams after evaluations are completed, keeping it as balanced as possible.
